APhA Resolution Process in Brief

*It all starts with a chapter member who develops an idea on how to change or improve the profession of pharmacy. The idea is brought to the chapter for discussion and to formulate it into a proposed resolution. (This is what we are doing tonight!) Then, through a series of hearings, House of Delegate meetings, and committee meetings at MRM, the resolution is either rejected or sent on to the APhA national meeting where the whole process repeats. If a resolution is adopted, it is sent to APhA's Board of Trustees who delegate it to the appropriate standing committee. The committees take action on resolutions and encourage chapters to implement resolutions on local levels where applicable. Through this process, students like us have an opportunity to improve the profession of pharmacy!
